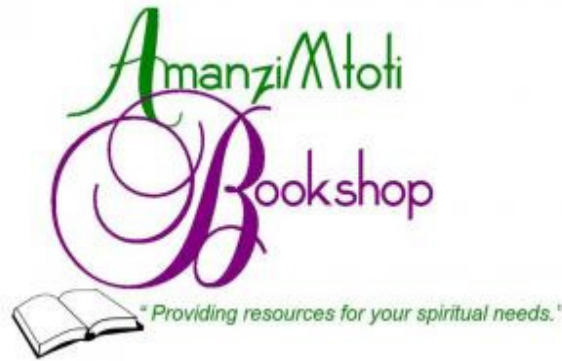

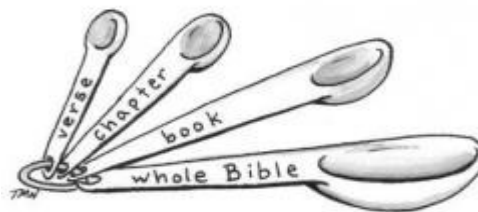

AManziMtoti is a isiZulu word that means "**Sweet waters**", history tells us that there is a place called **AmanziMtoti** named by King **uShaka Zulu** after drinking the water from a river or stream whilst on a raid against the Mpondos in the South Coast of KwaZulu Natal in 1828. According to Meitener, M.J. (1994) after drinking the water King Shaka exclaimed "Kanti amanz'amtoti"(isiZulu: "So, the water is sweet").

The name **AManziMtoti Christian Bookshop** was inspired by the story of the Samaritan woman in the bible in John 4.
